Language Teaching Travel Scholarship

(Established in 2013 by a donor to support future teachers of language other than English)

1 Purpose

The purpose of the Scholarship is to encourage and assist meritorious students who plan to be future teachers of a language other than English and language teachers who are undertaking their postgraduate studies, who will travel overseas to gain immersive experience in their target language.

2 Definitions

In these rules –

Scholarship means the Language Teaching Travel Scholarship

Head means the Head, School of Languages and Cultures

Overseas Study Program includes UQ Abroad or any program approved by the Head

3 Value and award of scholarship

- (1) The Senate may award a number of Scholarships each year, on the recommendation of the Head of School, after consultation with the donor.
- (2) The value of each Scholarship is \$5,000.

4 Eligibility for award

The Scholarship is open to students who –

- (a) are domestic students as defined in the Fee Rules; and
- (b) if they are an undergraduate student, have successfully completed at least 6 units of their language courses or if they are a postgraduate coursework student have completed at least 8 units; and
- (c) do not hold another comparable scholarship; and
- (d) have not previously held the Scholarship; and
- (e) submit the application to the Head by the closing date for applications; and
- (f) if they are an undergraduate student, have been accepted into the UQ Abroad Program to undertake at least 4 units of study towards their language major at a host university in a country where their target language is predominantly spoken or if they are a postgraduate coursework student, will undertake an intensive language course in a country where their target language is predominantly spoken as approved by the Head.

5 Selection of award

- (1) For the selection process, the Head of the School, must establish a selection committee comprising -
 - (a) the Head or nominee (who shall chair the committee); and
 - (b) a representative of the UQ School of Languages and Cultures and
 - (c) a representative of the UQ School of Education.
- (2) The Scholarship is awarded, at the discretion of the selection committee, to the applicant showing greatest merit as demonstrated by –
 - (a) academic achievement in their language courses; and
 - (b) a demonstrated interest and commitment to teaching in their target language and culture; and
 - (c) personal qualities, including leadership potential; and
 - (d) other matters that may be considered by the selection committee to be relevant to the applicant's future professional plans to become a teacher of a language other than English.

6 Conditions for scholarship

- (1) The Scholarship is tenable for the duration of the recipients' Overseas Study Program and will be paid upfront in one instalment, subject to the recipient –
 - (a) being accepted into the Overseas Study Program as outlined in their application and providing evidence of an airline receipt; and
 - (b) not holding another comparable scholarship.
- (2) If a recipient fails to satisfy the requirements in (6)(1) above, the student must show cause to the Head why the Scholarship should not be cancelled.

- (3) The Scholarship may be deferred only with the approval of the Head of the School and only in exceptional circumstances.
- (4) Within 1 month of returning to Australia the recipient must submit to the Head a written report of no more than 500 words on the work done and the benefits of the student overseas experience. The report may be reproduced for publication purposes.
