If you have already registered for the conference, **your registration fee** will be preserved. However, <u>please let us know if you would like to be refunded</u>. We will be issuing full refunds shortly, however, it may take several weeks for your funds to be processed and appear in your account.

We very much hope to be able to transfer over as much of the current programme as possible to the new dates, but we realise that some of you will not be able to make it. We will therefore also issue an additional call for papers in the future. Details of this will be circulated once they are available.
