

## **PATHWAY TO FRENCH MAJOR** Complete #16 units comprising: #0 to #4 units from French Level 1 Beginner Courses, and #6 units for all French Level 2 Compulsory Courses, and #0 to #4 units from French Level 2 Elective Courses, and #2 units for all French Level 3 Compulsory Courses, and #4 to #8 units from French Level 3 Elective Courses Students beginning French should start with Level 1 FREN courses; those who are at intermediate level should start with Level 2 FREN courses.
