

PATHWAY TO GERMAN MAJOR

Students with little or no German or students who completed Year 12 German more than 5 years ago should start with Level 1 courses; those who have completed Year 12 German should start with Level 2 courses and continue their language study to Advanced German 3 and 4.

Complete #16 units comprising:

#0 to #4 units from German Level 1 Beginner Courses, and

#4 units for all German Level 2 Compulsory Courses, and

#0 to #4 units from German Level 2 Elective Courses, and

#4 units for all German Level 3 Compulsory Courses, and

#2 to #8 units from German Level 3 Elective Courses

Students who have substantial, consolidated German language skills but did not complete Year 12 German may contact the discipline coordinator to determine the right starting point. Students should consult https://languages-cultures.uq.edu.au/study/whats-my-language-level level to receive more detailed information about the courses to complete according to their language level.
