

## PATHWAY TO RUSSIAN MINOR

**Complete #8 units comprising:**

**#0 to #4 units from Russian Level 1 Beginner Elective Courses, and  
#4 units for all Russian Level 2 Intermediate Compulsory Courses, and  
#0 to #4 units from Russian Level 2 Elective Courses**

**Students beginning Russian should start with Level 1 Courses; those who have experience learning Russian may start with Level 2 Courses.
