

## PATHWAY TO RUSSIAN MAJOR

**Complete 16 units comprising:**

**0 to 4 units from Russian Level 1 Elective Courses, and  
4 units for all Russian Level 2 Compulsory Courses, and  
2 to 6 units from Russian Level 2 Elective Courses, and  
4 units for all Russian Level 3 Compulsory Courses, and  
2 to 4 units from Russian Level 3 Elective Courses**

**Students beginning Russian should start with Level 1 Courses; those who are at intermediate level should start with Level 2 Courses.
