Abstracts (300-350 words, excluding references) need to be submitted via **email** (see below). In your abstract file please include: (1) title of the paper, (2) your full name, and (3) affiliation. All the abstracts will be anonymised prior to the peer-review process.

Data session proposals (on December 6)

On the second day of the conference, we will run a reading group meeting and a data session on the conference topics mentioned above. If you have a dataset you would like to explore in detail with the group, please submit your proposal (150-200 words, excluding a short data sample) via **email**. Your submission should include: (1) proposed topic, (2) short description of the data, (3) short data sample, (4) your full name, and (5) affiliation.

This conference is free of charge for presenters and attendees. The conference will be held in person.
