




# Graduate Certificate in Indigenous Language Revitalisation (GCILR) Application Guide

# Entry Requirements

To be eligible for entry, you'll need to be an Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person \*

You'll also need:

- bachelor's degree (or equivalent) in any discipline, or
- completed post-secondary studies plus two years full-time equivalent, relevant professional and/or community experience (see below), or
- five years full-time equivalent, relevant professional and/or community experience (see below).

\*Applicants are required to provide evidence of their Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander status. A confirmation of Aboriginality and/or Torres Strait Islander status identity under the Common Seal of a community organisation may be provided. Where exceptional circumstances apply, a Statutory Declaration with supporting materials may be considered. Original or certified copies of confirmation documents and/or supporting materials relevant to your identity must be provided. Certified copies must be witnessed by a Justice of the Peace (JP).

Post-secondary studies refers to any Australian Quality Framework Level 3, 4, 5 or 6 qualification; for example: Certificate III/IV/Diploma/Advanced Diploma.

Relevant professional and/or community experience includes:

- involvement in own Indigenous language work or community work that incorporates Indigenous languages; students will need to submit a CV or personal statement.

# Structure & Dates

You'll take [four core courses](#) to complete the Graduate Certificate.

Each course is taught through weekly on-line 1-2 hour seminars and a 1 week intensive on campus. Dates are set for 2025-2026.
