

## THE BRISBANE HOMESTAY KOMAZAWA BURSARY

(Established in 1994 and maintained by the income from a fund donated by the Brisbane Homestay and Friendship Association.)

- 1. The bursary is awarded annually by Senate on the recommendation of the Head of the School of Languages and Cultures.
- 2. The bursary must be used to enable an Australian student of the University, who has not previously visited Japan, to attend Komazawa University, Japan on a study program or, if one is not available, an exchange.
- 3. The bursary is open to students who have completed at least #2 of Japanese courses at the University.
- 4. The bursary is awarded on the basis of academic merit, financial need and the Head of School's assessment of who will benefit most from the experience taking acount of
- (a) exposure to the language;
- (b) appreciation of the culture; and
- (c) freedom from any responsibility which could adversely affect the full benefit being gained from the program or exchange.
- 5. The value of the bursary is the annual income of the fund.
